Japanese Language Program

Jobs are normally offered in the Retail, Hospitality Industries or in Factories. The University shall assist in procuring these Part-time jobs.

Final Job Placement

Final Jobs may be in Japan or a Japanese Company anywhere in the world. Students have to successfully clear their Management Course, clear the Japanese Language Program test and the Interview with the employer. It is important for the student to clear the N3 level in Japan to be eligible for Job Interviews.
